#### 1.4.5 OUTDOOR/HIKING

**26 Trekking boots** = Hiking, not for climbing



**27 Mountain shoe** = High alpine mountain shoe, for climbing but without a shell/mould.



**28 Moulded mountain boot** = High alpine mountain shoe made out of synthetic material for glacier tours and expeditions, waterproof and for climbing



**29 Climbing shoes** = for active climbing.



**30 Multifunction boot** = for hiking, limited suitability for mountains



**31 Multifunction shoe** = Flexible Outdoor shoe with a grip sole.



32 Trekking sandal



#### 1.4.6 FUN WHEEL SPORT

**PMGr. 69 – 73 Inline Skates** = vertical wheel position/-chassis



PMGr. 67 Roller Skates (Squad Skates) = horizontal wheel position/-chassis



Accessories of Fun wheel are categorised under "Hardware".

#### 1.4.7 ALPINE SKI SHOES

Here there are:

**48 Rear entry** = All-rounder boot with moveable flap at the heel for an easy entry. Possibility of a central locking system.



**49 Front entry** = Sporty ski boot with a classical construction with many straps for perfect fit (with diverse inner sole variations).



**51 Central entry** = Sporty and comfortable ski boot with extended help in entry due to flap over heel section that will lock and release in walking and skiing motion.



**53 Soft** = Due to the mixture of materials used; parts of the boot are made softer to improve comfort. Different fastening systems also improve wearability.
